<b>Lodging at the Decorah, Iowa accommodation of your choice.</b>	Varies depending on your choice of lodging. Link to Decorah Visitor's Bureau Accommodation Guide: <a href="https://www.visitdecorah.com/accommodations">https://www.visitdecorah.com/accommodations</a> Many options are available including motels, bed & breakfasts, Airbnb, camping, etc.	For this trip, everyone is requested to arrange their own lodging. Motel cost are highly inflated in the Decorah area for 2022 due to events during the weekend of our trip. I have opted to stay in an Airbnb in Decorah rather than a motel this year.
<b>Iowa Fishing License</b>	\$20.50 for 3 day nonresident license plus \$17.50 for trout stamp = <b>\$38.00. (an extra 1-day license can be added for \$12)</b> <b>OR</b> \$37.50 for 7 day nonresident license plus \$17.50 for trout stamp = <b>\$55.00</b> <b>OR</b> \$48 for annual nonresident license plus \$17.50 for trout stamp = <b>\$65.50.</b>	<b>-Each fisherman should purchase their license &amp; trout stamp online before the trip.</b> (Buying licenses at a local shop will be inconvenient & time consuming during the trip.) <b>Car Travel</b>	Travel costs including gas, tolls, road food, etc., are "on your own".	However, we can help coordinate if you prefer ride sharing.
