We provide an easy-to-understand overview to the sport of fly-fishing. All fly-fishing equipment and fly tying materials are provided by the Oak Brook Chapter Trout Unlimited.

**There is no cost to participants.**

The program is designed around the requirements of the Scouting America Fly-Fishing Merit Badge, so scouts who successfully complete the class will have met all the requirements of the merit badge. The staff includes merit badge counselors. Scouts are responsible for reading the Fly-Fishing Merit Badge book and bringing their blue "Application for Merit Badge Card" signed by their troop leader.

- Fly casting – overhead and roll cast
- FISHING – practicing catch and release
